# **Environmental**Awareness

This is a major concern within Hong Kong and its bad air quality is mainly attributed by motor vehicles, marine vessels and power plants-www.gov.hk. In particular, the challenge lies within 'local street-leveling pollution' and 'regional smog'-www.gov.hk. Whilst the Hong Kong government has been tackling this major issue, launched by the Environment bureau "A Clean Air Plan for Hong Kong", we can definitely do our small share.





Here are some things we can do to help improve our air quality!

- Greener travelling- Do you really need a car? If 'no', use the well-established public transportation system. If 'yes' check its fuel consumption.
- Car pooling- share a car to work with co workers and friends.
- Vehicle Maintenance- regular maintenance can reduce exhaust emission as well as possibly extending the life span of your vehicle.
- Don't accelerate or decelerate unnecessarily, because it increases fuel consumption.
- At work or home, make sure you have adequate ventilation- blocking air vents or ducts will cause problems.
- Try to use energy-efficiency products.
